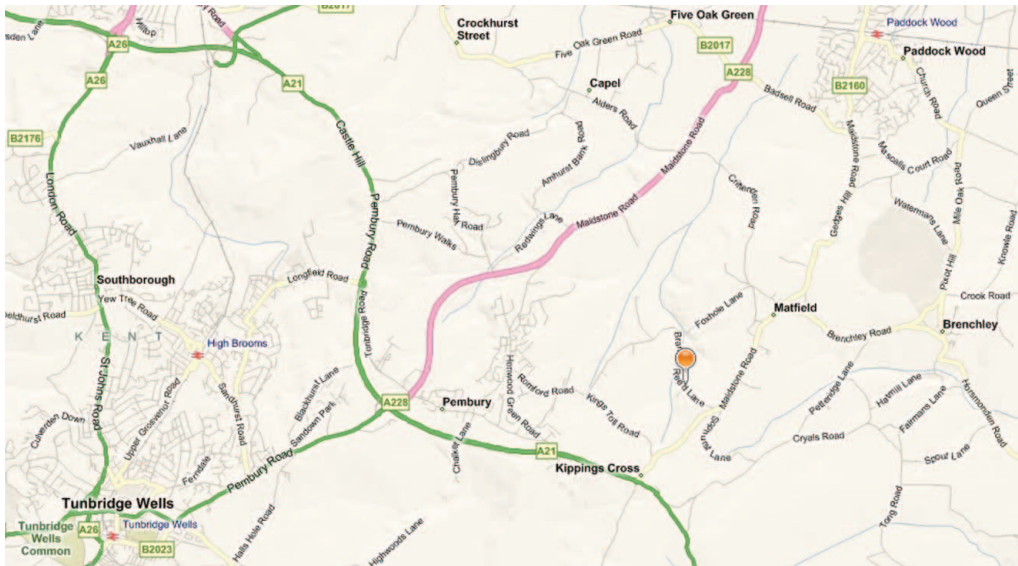

HOW TO FIND LODGE FARM (TN12 7ET)

Lodge Farm is a dedicated Cross Country Course. It is located south of Matfield, just off the B2160 which runs from the **Hop Farm** through Paddock Wood to the Kippings Cross roundabout on the A21. There will be signs on all roads to guide you to the farm. From the north (M25), south and west simply follow the A21 to **Kippings Cross** (just south of Pembury). From the south east follow the A262 to the A21. From the north east take the A228 to Mereworth and branch off on the A228 then to B2160 by the HOP FARM roundabout.

RULES & CONDITION OF ENTRY

1. **The decision of the judges and organisers is final.** All objections must be lodged in writing with the Secretary within 5 minutes after the finish of the Class together with a deposit of £15, which will be refunded, should the objection be upheld.
2. In order to gain access to Lodge Farm with a horse **WHETHER COMPETING OR NOT**, it is essential that the person responsible for the horse must be registered and obtains a Number. Any horse led or ridden without a number will not be permitted entry onto the Show ground. Tonbridge Lions try to mitigate untoward problems by having a First Aid team and vet on site. All numbered horse/rider combinations must pay £4 towards the cost of these facilities.
3. The Organisers and Lodge Farm disclaim any responsibility for anything that may happen to competitors or onlookers, their horses, vehicles or any of their property at this show. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree: a) that the Organisers and Lodge Farm shall not be responsible to the entrant for any accident happening, injury, loss or damage suffered by the entrant or any damage or loss of any chattel or property belonging to or in the possession of the entrant in connection with the Show and b) to indemnify the Organisers and Lodge Farm against any legal action arising from his/her entry in the show and c) to take full responsibility for damage caused by their horse or vehicle.
4. BHS approved **HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AND FASTENED AT ALL TIMES** when mounted. Correct dress must be worn in all classes.
5. Anyone found riding in a dangerous manner or ill-treating an animal will be asked to leave the show ground and Entry fees forfeited.
6. **ALL ACCIDENTS** must be reported to the Secretary.
7. Entries to all Classes will be limited at the discretion of the Organisers and they reserve the right to refuse any entry or to close any class and to alter the order, timing or composition of the schedule without reason.
8. **DOGS** must be on a **LEAD** and under the control of A RESPONSIBLE PERSON **AT ALL TIMES**.
9. Riders competing on the **Leading Rein** may only enter Classes in Ring 7, Condition and Turnout, In Hand Classes, Fancy Dress, Lead rein Scurry and Lead Rein Gymkhana. Lead Rein riders must remain on the **leading rein AT ALL TIMES when mounted**.
10. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years may be **ridden** at the show.
11. No whips or spurs are permitted in Gymkhana events. No misuse of whips/spurs will be tolerated.
12. Entry Fees will not be refunded unless a Veterinary or Medical certificate is produced before the commencement of the show. Challenge trophies are the property of Tonbridge Lions and must be returned when requested. A £10 deposit is made on all Challenge Trophies which will be returned on receipt of the trophy.
13. **TWO PHASE (Rule 192)**. A Rider who jumps a clear round **will continue immediately** over the Jump off Course and the bell will only be rung if the rider **has not** completed a Clear round.
14. The Show may be cancelled if the ground is too wet. Check with the Secretary. In case of cancellation a fee of £4.00 per entry will be kept to cover costs and for donations to the Charities.
15. All Class winners will be requested to pay a cash deposit of £10 for their trophy which will be refunded next year.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: Lodge farm and the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the organisers and all Officials and Stewards
